Dear Parents and Carers

WORLD BOOK DAY

At the end of last term we were all privileged to witness the hatching of chicks from eggs. All of the children had an opportunity to hold a chick. We had a wonderful two weeks of learning, with plenty of opportunities for children to show care and concern for the tiny baby chicks.

Story Groups

For many of our children this is the last term of Nursery. We would like to develop, accelerate and extend the learning of all children in this next term to ensure they are in the best possible place before starting Reception. To support with this we will shortly be starting a new system for story groups. Children will still have the same keyworker, but at the end of the session we will be grouping children together based on what they need most to support further learning. This might mean that you will collect your child from a different adult and a different group. We will try to keep the groups as consistent as possible so you always know where to find your child at collection time.

Library Days

Changing our system of story groups at the end of the session means we will need to change our system of library days. Children will continue using the library, however keyworkers will take them to the library during the session, rather than at the end of the session as we have done up to this point. So please collect your child from the classroom every day.

Please note that staff will no longer return library books for you, so please pop into the library and return them yourself.

Toys from Home

Please do not allow your child to bring toys (including sunglasses) from home into Nursery. Unfortunately toys from home often get lost and broken and this results in unnecessary tears. Please also ensure your child does not have toys in the bags they hang on their pegs.

School Places

If your child is due to start Reception in September you should have heard about a school place by now. If you have not then please speak to Chantal August at Reception. Please ensure you follow the procedure suggested to accept the school place. If you do not follow this procedure your child may lose the place.

Sports Day

Thank you for your understanding when we postponed the Sports Day due to rainy weather. We have now rescheduled it for **Friday 22 June.**

Breakfast Club

We are pleased to be able to offer a breakfast club at Lea Nursery from the 8th of May. Breakfast club will run from 8:00am- 8:35am. The number of places at breakfast club are limited and need to be pre-booked with Chantal August at Reception. This club is only available to children who are 3-4 years of age. There is a £3 a day charge for the service, unless your child is entitled to a 30 hour place and this time forms part of their 30 hours.

Parent Groups

We have had consistently good attendance at our parent groups in the last term. This term we have the following parent groups on offer:

- A four week program run by the Children's Centre Family Support Worker on aspects of parenting (particularly supporting children's behaviour.) The dates for this group are Thursday the 3rd, 10th, 17th and 24th of May between 9:00am and 11:00am. Please speak to Mrs Butt if you would like more information about this group.
- Wednesday 6th of June- Supporting children's independence. (This is the workshop to attend if your child is still in nappies and if your child still has a bottle or a dummy.)
- Wednesday 4th of July- Supporting children's literacy development.

Photographer

We have a photographer taking individual photographs of children on Thursday the 10th of May. Please dress your child accordingly on the day. If you would like a photograph of your child with his/her brothers or sisters please let staff know and this can be arranged at the beginning of the session.

Clothing

Please ensure that your child is appropriately dressed for the weather, this includes wearing sun cream and hats on sunny days. Please also ensure that your child wears shoes that are appropriate for running and climbing. Please try to label your child's clothing with his/her name.


New Children Visiting
