There is a £3 per day charge for the breakfast club (unless it forms part of the 30 hours for children with a 30 hour place.) Please note that this service needs to be booked beforehand- children will not be allowed to join the breakfast club on the day. This club is also only available to children who are 3-4 years of age.

## **Bike and Scooter Day**

We would like to invite all children to bring their bike or scooter into Nursery on **Thursday the 5<sup>th</sup> of July.** Please don't worry if your child does not have a bike or a scooter- we will put the Nursery bikes outside for children to ride too.

## **Summer Term Outings**

You should have all received information about the summer term outings. We will be visiting Legoland on **Monday** 16<sup>th</sup> of July and Ruislip Lido on **Wednesday the 18<sup>th</sup> of July.** Places on these outings are allocated on a first come, first serve basis.
