Clothing

As the weather starts to get cooler please ensure that your child brings a coat to Nursery every day. We want all children to be warm when they play outside, so children are not allowed to go outside if they are not wearing a coat. We would like all children to learn to put their own coat on. This is the way we teach them to do it- please help your child by practising at home.

- 1. Put the hood of the coat by your child's feet.
- 2. Get your child to put his/her arms in the sleeves.
- 3. Get your child to flip the coat over his/her head.
- 4. Hey presto- your child will have his/her coat on!
- 5. Show your child how to do up the zip by fastening the bottom bit and encouraging him/her to pull it up.



Focus Children

Thank you to all of the parents who have already taken cameras home and spent time taking photographs with your child. Children love to talk about their own photographs. Thank you also for filling in the information sheet about your child. All of these things help us to support the learning and development of children. If your child hasn't yet had a turn please don't worry. All children will have a turn before the December holidays.

We have planned a trip to **Jump in** Slough on **Thursday 8**th **of November**

The plan for the day is as follows: 9:00am- Coach leaves Lea Nursery

9:30am- Arrive and watch a safety video (all families need to watch this)

10:00am- Jump and jump and jump 12:00pm- Coach leaves Jump in 12:30pm- Arrive back at Nursery

<u>The Nursery will be open as normal for children who aren't going on the trip.</u> If your child normally attends the afternoon session please feel free to bring your child on this outing but keep him/her at home in the afternoon. **You do not need to bring a picnic.**

Due to the age of the children we rely heavily on parents to accompany children on trips. There are only **4** places available for unaccompanied children. We may be able to accommodate some younger siblings, but only if they are old enough to travel on the coach without a car seat. The unaccompanied places will be offered according to the following priority:

- Children who have not yet been on a trip as an unaccompanied child.
- Families where both parents work (and in the case of single parents, the single parent works.)
- Parents who are doing a course and have to attend college, university or other educational setting on that day.
- Parents who have a younger child who is unable to go along due to car seat requirements.

The cost of the trip is as follows:

To go by coach: £30 for one adult and one child.

To meet us at Jump in Slough: £20 for one adult and one child

For an unaccompanied child: £10.

If you are unable to afford the cost of the trip but would like to attend please do come and talk to me about it.

Reception. There are 70 places available on the coach and places will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis
