Dear Parents and Carers

I've been facing lots of questions about Coronavirus and possible school closure. I thought it best to update you via newsletter.

In addition to this we've got lots packed into the next few months and this newsletter gives you details of some of these exciting activities and events.

Coronavirus



As all of you will be aware there is a great deal of fear and uncertainty circulating about Coronavirus. The government's guidance on the coronavirus has changed from the 'contain' phase to one of delaying the spread of the virus. In light of this the following information will let you know what we're doing, and what we expect from all of you, to help make sure our school community keeps safe and calm.

We'd like to reassure you we're taking all of the necessary steps to protect our community and are continuing to follow official guidance from the government and Slough Borough Council.

What's the current situation?

- The Nursery remains open this is the current official guidance we've been given.
- All Nursery functions including walking bus, breakfast club and trips continue to run as normal.
- We have chosen to postpone the trip to Odd's Farm on the 21st of April but we will definitely be going in June so children won't miss out.
- Children should attend Nursery unless they feel unwell if your child has any of the following symptoms they should remain at home for 7 days:
 - o a new, continuous cough and/or
 - o a temperature.
- If your child is unwell, report this as you would normally by phoning, texting or e-mailing. Please let us know if your child is unwell and the reason for their illness. If you are choosing to self-isolate your child then please let us know this so we can record the absence under the right code.
- We'll keep you up to date with any changes to the current situation.

What we're doing to protect and support pupils and staff

Please be reassured that we are taking every precaution to ensure that the Nursery is as safe as possible for children, for example door handles, exit buttons and touch screens are being cleaned frequently throughout the day.

We are talking to children about hygiene, this includes teaching the right technique for hand washing. Please continue to talk to children about the following principles:

- Covering their mouth when they sneeze or cough (using a tissue or elbow.) The tissue should be thrown straight in the bin and they should wash their hands with soap afterwards.

- Avoiding touching their eyes, nose and mouth. (This includes discouraging children from sucking their own thumbs and fingers.)

Children with persistent coughs or temperatures will be isolated and sent home immediately. Please ensure you come and collect your child straight away if we ask you to.

What happens if Nursery has to close?

We'll only close if we're either officially advised to do so or we don't have enough staff to run the Nursery.

If this is the case we'll text you to let you know that Nursery will be closed. Please ensure we have the correct contact information, otherwise you won't get the text! We will contact you via text again to let you know when Nursery will reopen.

Please keep in mind that we're only sending out this information to help you prepare. There are currently no plans to close.

It means that we will be closed on this day and will reopen on the 21st of April. You will see in the diary below that I've amended the INSET days at the end of the academic year and instead of having two training days then we will now only have one. My apologies for the disruption, however I hope you will understand the need to get moving on developing children's learning in the outdoor area.
