We have had new play equipment installed in both playgrounds and there is further work planned for the summer term.

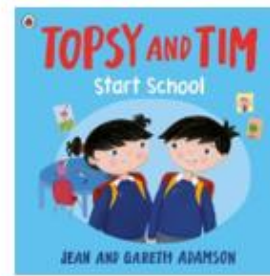
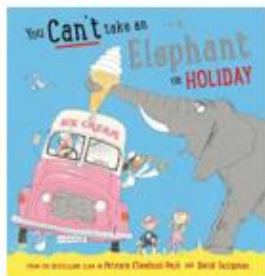
The children looked very smart for their school photographs and by now everyone should have received their copies. All orders need to be sent directly through Tempest Photography.
