

Lea Nursery and Mighty Acorn Carparking Policy

Slough Borough Council (Advisor)

Schools' main public parking areas

As directed in our travel plan policy, all members of the public driving a vehicle on the schools' site must do so without causing any danger to pedestrians and with respect to other drivers. All school staff from Willow Primary School, Iqra Primary School, Lea Nursery School and Mighty Acorns must be spoken to in interacted with respectfully.

If a member of staff asks a member of the public to move their vehicle this must be actioned. Harassment, uncordial behaviour or parking or driving that is considered to be dangerous will result in the driver and vehicle being banned from the schools' site.

Use of staff carparks

Safeguarding

Due to safeguarding all users of the staff carpark must be known to the SLT at Lea Nursery School, Mighty Acorns or Slough Borough Councils Building Management team.

Visitors must use the intercom system to call the relevant setting to be allowed entry. Entry and use of the staff car park is managed by the individual nurseries.

All vehicles must be insured and have a current up to date MOT to ensure the vehicles are road worthy and safe.

Children must be transported in an appropriate car seat with suitable safety harness.

Children must not be left unattended in vehicles.

Pedestrian parents must keep their children supervised and safe at all times when walking through the site and car parks.

Parking

All users of the car park must park correctly inside the marked bays.
